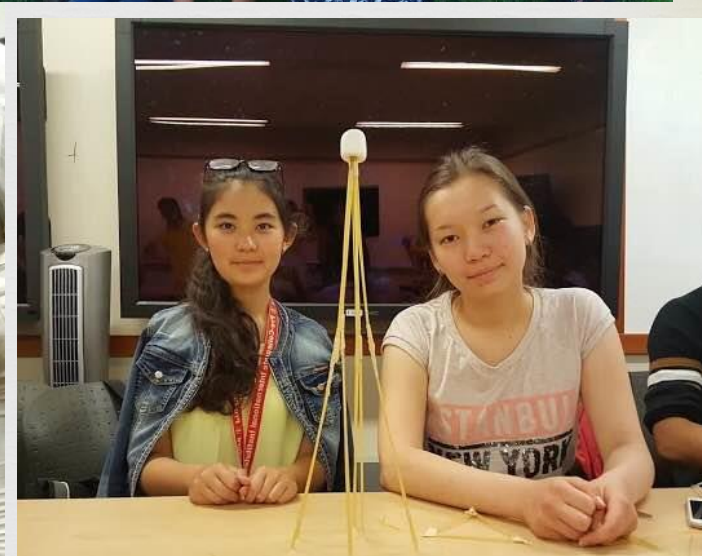

- ✧ English language proficiency
- ✧ Level of study
- ✧ Academic performance

Procedure



- ❧ Forming a list of students based on performance averages
- ❧ Test of subjects in English
- ❧ Final decision is carried out on pedagogical councils:
 - ❧ Course overview
 - ❧ Students characteristics (by curators and teachers)
 - ❧ Voting
