On November 14, 2018, the Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the EU project "Support to the education system in Turkmenistan" and AO "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools" (hereinafter referred to as NIS)





Joint efforts for in-service teacher training of teachers in Turkmenistan

- Training programs on «School leadership and management», «Innovative methods of teaching», «Modern trends of Education» were delivered by NIS Center of Pedagogical Excellence.
- The programs for Turkmen teachers were developed on the basis in-service trainign programmes for teachers in Kazakhstan, certified by The Accreditation, Certification and Quality Assurance Institute ACQUIN (Germany).





A modular approach was used during trainings. It helps to keep continuity between the stages of program. Individual coursework was implemented between trainings 'stages.





Further training participants are:

- secondary school teachers from Ashgabat and velayats (regions of Turkmenistan)
- School managers from Ashgabat and velayats,
- Employees of National Institute of Education and the Centers for Professional Development of teachers



- Total number of participants 161 persons.
- > Average age 45 year.
- Pedagogical experience of participants
 - more that 20 years.













Key learning outcomes:

- As a result of implemented trainings the participants upgraded their conceptual comprehension of teaching and learning;
- The systematic work about practice on development of critical thinking skills was conducted, relevants methods and approaches in teaching process were presented and discussed;
- The participants have expressed their aspiration to cooperate and continue joint efforts with Kazakh partners in the framework of educational projects.



Key learning outcomes:

- ► The process of microteaching contributed to development of lesson planning skills µ and development of ability to create constructive feedback during the lesson.
- Participants of seminars started approbation of new teaching methods aimed to increase teaching quality and now they have to disseminate the competences obtained;
- As the participants emphasized, due to consistent studies of the training programme delivered, its permanent interaction with practical implementation of the proposed approaches in the school the first positive outcomed of the training course may be oberved.







The participants received 117 methodological materials, develoed by the NIS trainers, as well as received certificates upon completion of the course.





NIS also developed a seminar "Effective Lesson:Planning, Monitoring, Reflection", implemented in the period from 3rd to 21st June 2019:


- A contemporary lesson. Modern approaches in training and learning
