



Concept and purpose of research


as a positive interaction is the most important factor of learning to determine how teachers interact with learners and how teachers are motivated to build value-based relationships in order to have a positive effect on student learning.

Teacher-student relationship



- Canter (1997): "They do not like the subject, because the students do not like teachers, and the students show low results"
- Cox (1996): «If adults treat the child with dignity, children respect others. They feel care from the adults, they take care of others».
- Marzano(2003): "In the absence of good communication, students will be opposed to any disciplinary actions, rules, and procedures"
- According to Zehm and Cottler (1993), students will never trust us until they feel that we respect and respect them.


Research methods:

- The study was conducted in 2018-2019 academic year.
- 80 pupils from 4 schools participated in the study.
- To improve the reliability and reliability of the data, 2 urban schools and 2 rural schools were selected.
- 40 pupils from the 5th and 6th grade and 40 pupils from the 9th to 10th grades took part in determining the opinion of pupils of various ages.
- Reliability and validity of data (Golafshani, 2003)
- Patton (2001) «Triangulation of data collection method strengthens the study»



- ✓ there is a relationship that leads to learning in the classroom
- ✓ teachers take responsibility for the students' academic achievement
- ✓ teachers respect the pupils' emotions and moods
- ✓ teachers support students
- ✓ there is a reliable dialogue between the pupil and the teacher

Good relationship






- Warmth accept your students for who they are and care for them as a good parent cares for their child. Show them that they are important to you.

- Time take the time to physically and mentally present when talking with your students.




