reflection of their own assessment activities in the context of teacher training for presentation protection

empirical observation of the evaluation process during presentation protection

surveying the teachers to identify attitudes towards assessment procedures

conversations, interviews with trainers in order to identify problems arising in the course of preparation for presentation protection, to determine satisfaction with the assessment process;

working with trainers to organize the process of assessing presentation protection

Object of the study - is the process of assessing of the presentations of teachers in one-week courses on the updated content of education.



Subject of the research - methods, techniques, tools and ways to improve the effectiveness of the assessment process in protecting presentations.



Purpose of the study - is to develop tools to provide effective support to the trainer during the preparation and conduct of the assessment of teachers' presentations.

Research Objectives:

- analyze the results of the assessment of one-week courses on the updated educational content in the study period;
- describe the conditions and prerequisites conducive to the successful protection of presentations;
- reveal the essence and practical significance of recommendations for the successful assessment of the protection of presentations;

- provide tools to effectively support assessment practice.

Conclusions: analyzing the results of one-week courses, several factors influence the results obtained:

motivation of teachers of the courses trainers of these courses are teachers themselves, who conduct courses once a year, at the time of the courses, in particular (of the first groups), the skills and experience of assessment are still forgotten; untimely arrival of students: late for 1-2-3 days, despite the fact that the courses are of 5-day duration.


Recommendations:

- 1. Pay attention to descriptors; they are compiled for tasks. Some listeners compose descriptors to the evaluation criteria.
- 2. According to the criterion "Objectives of the lesson" there is a statement, they just read the objectives, justification should be given. You do NOT need to read components to the criteria, you need to provide evidence.
- 3. Pay attention to the evidence according to the criterion "Methods of differentiation", here it is necessary to present the methods of differentiation planned in the lesson, stop and reveal in detail 1-2 methods of differentiation, specifically by example.
- 4. The lesson should not be fully described. It is necessary to provide evidence by criteria. In fact, there is a description of the lesson, with a lot of slides (13-17), the teachers practically do not have time to show all the slides and the necessary evidence remains unsolved ... "






