School mediation service

School mediation- procedure for the settlement of a dispute (conflict) between participants in the educational process with the participation of a mediator - a neutral mediator, interested only in the parties resolving the conflict to the maximum advantage for both parties.

mediation helps resolve disputes (conflicts) between:

- students;
- educators;
- students and parents;
- students and educators;
- parents and educators



- mediator neutrality
- equality of sides
- confidentiality







Objective: to identify and justify the psychological conditions for increasing the effectiveness of school mediation in resolving disputes between conflicting parties

Research hypothesis: the effectiveness of training professional mediators increases if the following conditions are met:

the formation of students' stable ideas about the professional activity of the mediator, proceeding in interaction with the parties to the conflict;

Mastering by students in the course of training the experience of professional activity and its individual elements;

systematic provision of students with detailed feedback on the progress and results of their interaction in educational and professional ones.

Psychological characteristics of training programs for professional mediators and evaluating its effectiveness

Training of mediators in accordance with the tradition established abroad is carried out in a combination of lecture-seminar and training forms. In the Republic of Kazakhstan, currently, in order to implement paragraph 4 of Article 9 of the Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated January 28, 2011 "About Mediation", special rules have been developed special rules for training under the mediator training program. In this regard, work with mediators provide the necessary minimum of knowledge to obtain the status of a professional mediator, advanced training of a mediator and teaching mediation. The programs of training courses for professional mediators are divided into general and specialized, each of them differs in the content of the material and the curriculum

The content of the training of professional mediators is determined by an approximate curriculum approved by order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan, however, until now there is no single educational standard for the profession of mediator, the question of competences of the mediator, criteria for certification and evaluation of already trained students and practicing mediators remains open. When planning the content and form of training, many centers are guided by the experience gained in Europe, America, Australia and other countries

School practice mediation

In this regard, new types of social activity arise, aimed at harmonizing the interaction of individuals, groups, organizations, finding ways and means of effective conflict-free resolution of existing contradictions. One of the specialties that meet this social request is the specialty of a mediator

Organization of the activities of the school mediation service

The goal of the school mediation service is the implementation in educational institutions of a restorative approach to responding to conflicts and offenses. In the process of its activity, the mediation service solves the following tasks aimed at working with conflicts and tension in the school community:

conducting mediation (conciliation programs) between the conflicting parties, as well as between the offender and the victim performance at the city level and in the media, participation in conferences, gatherings, trainings, specialized shifts

teaching students constructive communication and mediation

education and presentation events for the entire school (teachers, parents, administration and students) in order to clarify the values of the restorative approach and increase the number of situations referred to mediation

establishing mutual understanding between different people, organizing "school conferences" and "circles" to solve problematic issues important for the school community In school services, mediators (subject to training for restorative mediation) can be:



parents, employees of a public or state organization, or another adult in agreement with the administration of an educational institution

students

teaching staff of the educational institution "Curators"

Directions of work of curators of the school

Implementation of restorative practices in the educational institution and the formation of restorative culture:

creation of a support group for the school mediation service from teachers and students

analyse of the dominant ways of responding to conflicts in an educational institution

informing the school community about the results of the mediation service (taking into account the confidentiality of what is happening at the meeting)

work with the teaching staff of an educational institution aimed at adopting a restorative approach to resolving conflicts, criminal situations and tense relationships Organization of the work of the school mediation service in specific situations:

registration of applications received by the service

for each case: deciding whether to take the case to work, which program to conduct (mediation, "community circle" or "family conference"), the choice of mediators

work with the student's social environment and parents

supporting mediation and "community circles" by student mediators

conducting recovery programs for complex cases (criminal situations, conflicts involving teachers and parents)

description of work with cases

supervision of mediators-students (analysis of the work of mediators for compliance with restorative mediation standards)

holding an analytical meeting with parties to the conflict (2-4 weeks after mediation)

School mediation: student mediator training program

- Nowadays, psychological and pedagogical practice does not have universally recognized, widely tested and proven to be undoubtedly effective technologies for preparing school mediators from among students.
- The first step towards its solution can be the answer to four key questions related to the training programs for mediators of the school mediation service from among children: "what to teach?", "How to teach?", and "whom to teach?".

«What to teach?»

- elementary knowledge from the field of psychology of communication, developmental psychology, psychology of conflict;
- mastering the technology of the mediation process in the conflict;
- self-presentation;
- active listening;
- analysis and forecast of the development of the communicative situation;
- the formation of constructive motivation for mediation;
- to get ready to put into practice its basic principles: impartiality, confidentiality, voluntariness.

«How to teach?»

• The program relies on active learning methods (game design, role-playing, discussions and others) within the framework of the training format for organizing educational activities

«Whom to teach?»


• It is optimal to involve teenagers who have reached a certain level of psychological maturity and have a certain amount of life experience in the mediation service, which are a necessary condition for understanding the essence of mediation and mastering its technological aspects

«Whom to teach?»


 Curator of the school mediation service, that is, a psychologist or teacher familiar with the principles of mediation and sharing them, having experience in implementing conflict mediation technology

Questioning Awareness of educational institutions of Shchuchinsk about the mediation procedure, the conditions for its implementation "




In your opinion what are the main problems during negotiations?




What qualities of mediation are most important for you?




Have you made any attempts in your practice to resolve the dispute among the teachers and parents without contacting other authorities (education department, akimat, court).




In accordance with the law, mediation is negotiations with the participation of an independent impartial mediator (mediator). what do you think is his role?




If you enter into negotiations, to whom are you ready to turn to apply in their implementation?




If you enter into negotiations, to whom are you ready to turn to apply in their implementation?




In what conditions are you ready to apply to the services of a mediator?




What expressions, in your opinion, most accurately characterize negotiations?

- This curriculum has a high degree of pedagogical expediency. The program "Mediation". The direction of training trainers-mediators "was drawn up and is being implemented within the framework of the adopted law" About Mediation "of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
- In the process of mastering the program, students will gain knowledge about the methodological foundations and principles of teaching a restorative approach, the mediative approach and the mediation procedure and the school mediation method, as well as about the features of the methods and methods of working with the group, the specifics of the work of the school mediation trainer





Creating a school reconciliation service is a civilized way to resolve conflicts in the school environment. The training lesson assumes familiarity with the basics of conflict management, with an analysis of the impact on the development of events of emotional states, with the laws of negotiations in an accessible form for students.
